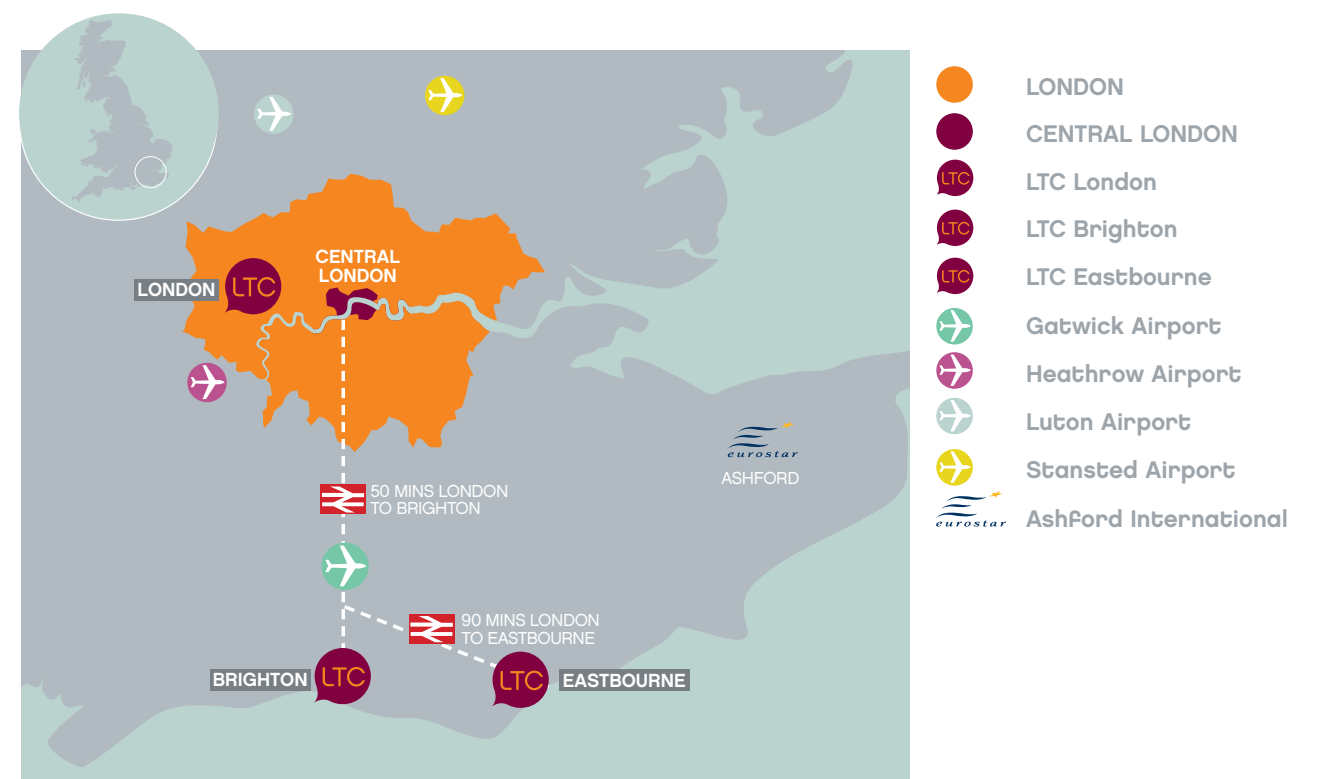


At LTC our aim is simple – to offer you the best language learning experience possible.

General English Standard Course

All levels from elementary to advanced (CEFR strong A1-A2 to C1).

In this default option, afternoon classes concentrate on speaking, listening and writing.

General English + Business English

Intermediate to advanced only (CEFR B1 to C1).

Afternoon lessons focus on the language and practical skills needed to communicate effectively in business and professional situations.

General English + IELTS Exam Preparation

Intermediate to advanced only (CEFR B1 to C1).

Afternoon classes focus on the skills and strategies necessary for a good IELTS score.

Year Round Group Courses

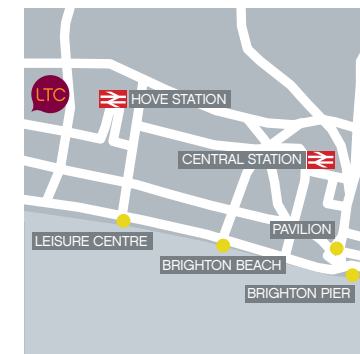

Living in Homestay

Feeling safe, comfortable and welcome at all times is a key factor in getting the most from your stay in England.

To use your English and experience UK culture we recommend living with one of our carefully chosen homestay providers.

All three schools have homestay close to the schools - on average 20-30 minutes' walk or a short bus ride. Some are much closer as the schools are all located very near residential areas. Please note that in peak periods travelling distances may be longer.

We visit all our hosts before placing students with them and monitor student feedback to ensure you have the best possible experience. See also Private Homes.

Residential Accommodation

Private Homes In busy periods, adult students may be placed in Private Homes rather than Homestay. The difference is that in Private Homes, there are more than four students living in the house. Please tell us if you do not wish to stay in Private Home accommodation.

Residential Dormitories Eastbourne offers shared residential dormitory accommodation for students age 10-16. This is reserved for groups in spring, autumn and winter but in the summer, it is also available for individuals.

Other Accommodation Options

Self-catering student houses, hostels, hotels and guest houses are also available. Please contact the schools for more information – they are happy to give advice.

→ Homestay key points

- All homestay is within easy travelling distance of our schools
- Our homestay is carefully selected, inspected and monitored by our accommodation staff according to English UK guidelines.
- Homestay for adults is normally half-board: breakfast & evening meal
