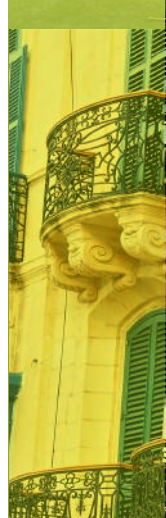
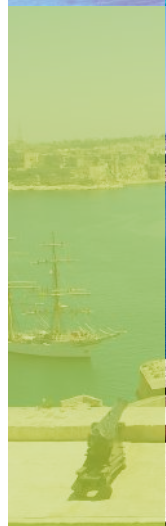
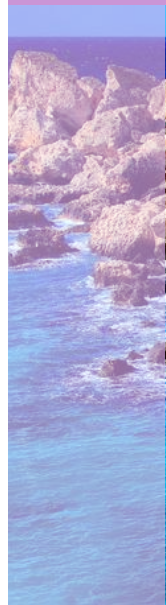
ST PAUL'S BAY

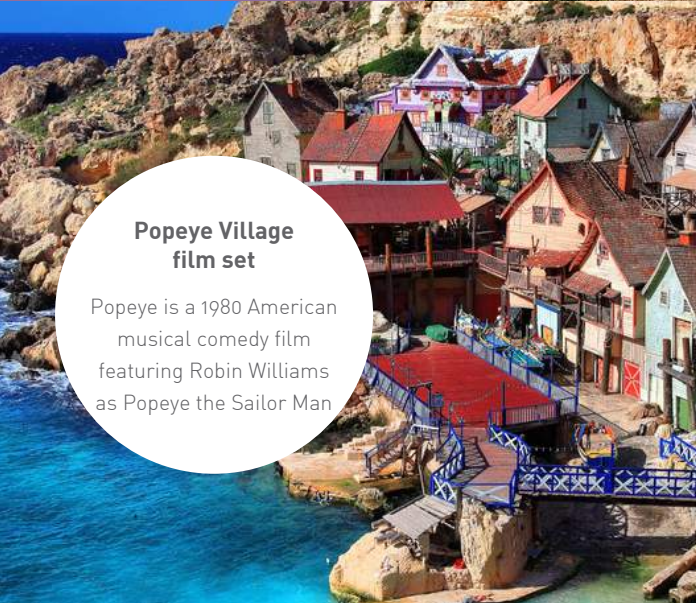

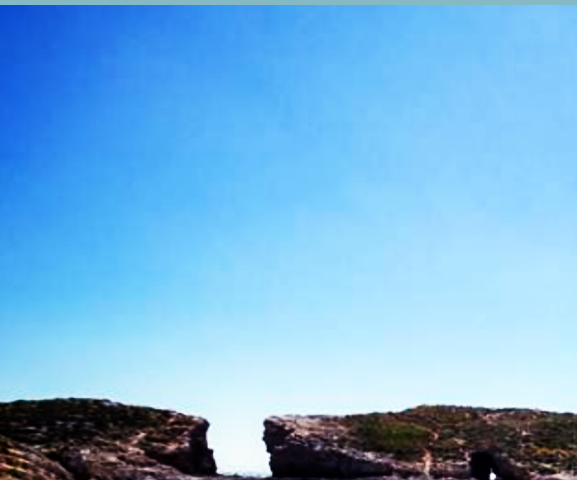

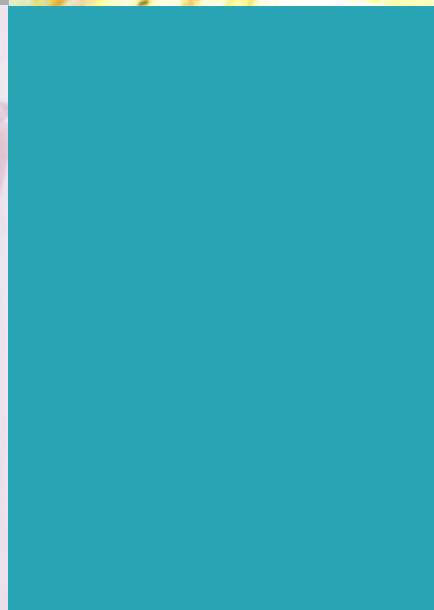

GV SUMMER CAMP

GV CAMP IS THE PERFECT OPPORTUNITY FOR BOYS AND GIRLS, AGED 10 TO 17, TO PRACTISE ENGLISH IN AN IMMERSIVE ENVIRONMENT, MAKE FRIENDS FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD, PARTICIPATE IN A VARIETY OF SPORTS, EXCURSIONS AND ACTIVITIES, AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, HAVE FUN!

GV Camp operates weekly, from Monday 27 June until Friday 26 August 2016, and campers may book their stay from 1 week+. There are four options to choose from:

- Residential Camp
(full programme, including Saturday & Sunday)
- Host Family Camp
(full programme, including Saturday & Sunday)
- Day Camp
(weekdays 09:00 – 18:00, optional Saturday & Sunday)
- Language Camp
(weekdays 09:00 – 12:45, optional Saturday & Sunday)

WHAT IS A GV RESIDENTIAL CAMP?

Our Residential camp is the regular, full package we offer where English lessons, accommodation and daily activities, including Saturdays and Sundays, are held 'under one roof'. Local excursions to discover other parts of Malta are also included in this package.

Rooms: Students may choose between twin/triple or single bedroom options with full en suite shower/bathroom. Some twin rooms may have bunk beds. The rooms are cosy and modern, equipped with new furniture and fans.

Dormitories: Students may also opt to stay in one of our comfortable, modern dormitories. Each student will have a wardrobe and shared bathroom facilities. Maximum number of bunk beds: 26 or 32 per dorm.

Boys and girls are housed separately and supervised at all times by our experienced staff.

Meals: Students are offered a healthy and varied full-board option consisting of Breakfast, Hot Lunch and Buffet Dinner, all on campus. Occasionally we provide an outdoor BBQ for supper to enjoy the Mediterranean summer night's breeze outdoors! Students are encouraged to try different foods to promote a healthy and balanced diet. Vegetarian and Special dietary requirements are also catered for and should be advised upon booking.

Return Airport transfers: airport-Camp-airport included in the programme.

WHAT IS A GV HOST FAMILY CAMP?

Our Host Family camp is very similar to our regular GV Residential Camp, the only difference being that students are accommodated in host families close to the camp. The students participate in the full leisure programme, including Saturdays and Sundays.

Meals: Students are offered a continental breakfast and dinner with their host families. Hot lunch is served at the camp. Students are encouraged to try different foods to promote a healthy and balanced diet. Vegetarian and Special dietary requirements are also catered for and to be advised upon booking.

Return Airport transfers: airport-Host Family-airport included in the programme.

WHAT IS A GV DAY CAMP?

Our Day Camp is a shorter version of our regular GV Camp, including the leisure programme (Monday to Friday) but without the overnight accommodation. Campers have the option to sleep in their parents' accommodation and take a 15-minute shuttle from St. Paul's Bay area to the Camp.

Meals: Hot lunch is served at the camp (Monday to Friday) and included in the programme. Students are encouraged to try different foods to promote a healthy and balanced diet. Vegetarian and Special dietary requirements are also catered for and to be advised upon booking. Breakfast and Dinner not included in the programme.

Shuttles: included in the price.

WHAT IS A GV LANGUAGE CAMP?

Our Language Camp includes English lessons only, without the leisure programme and without the overnight accommodation/meals. Campers have the option to sleep in their parents' accommodation and take a 15-minute shuttle from St. Paul's Bay area to the Camp.

Meals: not included.

Shuttles: included in the price.

GV SUMMER CAMP

WHAT HAPPENS AT GV ENGLISH SUMMER CAMP?

So much happens at our Summer Camp it's hard to know how we fit it all in!

Here's a sample of a weekly programme:

08:00: Wake up time, morning exercises and Breakfast for our Residential students.

08:45: Shuttle leaves St. Paul's Bay to drive Language and Day students to Camp.

09:00: Upon arrival of the Language, Day and Host Family students at the Camp, a meeting is held with our GV Team Coordinator, GV Language Coordinator and GV Team Leaders to brief all students about what's going to happen during the day.

09:15 – 12:45: Monday to Friday students enjoy 3 hours per day / 15 hours per week of exclusive morning English lessons. The level-appropriate classes are made up of a maximum of 15 students allowing time for personalised attention.

12:45: Language students leave camp to catch shuttle to St. Paul's Bay.

Hot lunch served on Camp to Residential, Host Family and Day Campers.

14:00: Afternoons: Campers can look forward to a wide variety of healthy-living activities, including team sports, outdoor / indoor recreation, the arts and excursions.

Such activities may include football, volleyball, badminton, basketball, swimming and snorkelling in the Mediterranean Sea, hiking, movie making, bowling, painting, geocaching, photography, dance, yoga, hip hop and water games to name some of the many options.

To complete the balanced schedule there are well-planned excursions with historical & cultural visits to Mdina and Valletta, Treasure Hunts, time for shopping, traditional local crafts sessions like pottery and limestone-carving and endless fun; some of these will certainly be among the highlights of their holiday. Some afternoon

activities are offered as 'Sign-Up' options, while others are pre-set for the entire group.

18:00: Day Campers leave camp by shuttle to St. Paul's Bay to join their families for dinner.

Host family Campers return to their host families to take a shower and freshen up and join their host families for dinner.

Residential Campers take a shower & freshen up, followed by a Hot Buffet Dinner at the camp.

Time Out: Everyday between 18:00 – 20:00 some private time is dedicated to relax and chill out, or to contact parents/friends in own home country. Parents are urged to contact their children only at these times, unless in case of emergency.

20:00: Evenings Host Family students return to GV Camp to join in the evening activities.

Evenings include a wide variety of group activities that encourage social and English language interaction among the campers.

Such activities may include Welcome Parties, mini discos, game nights, ping pong tournaments, dances, talent shows, mini speed dating, karaoke and even camper organized special events.

22:00: Host family campers return to their homestays for a much needed sleep.

22:30: Lights out. Time to sleep and dream in English!

Saturday is the big excursion day for our Residential and Host Family campers (optional for Language and Day Campers), when you get to discover the best of the Maltese islands.

Sunday is also a fun-packed day for our Residential and Host Family campers (*optional for Language and Day Campers*), where you may have Sports Contests or participate in a best Photo Quest. You will have the time to prepare for the evening International Fest where students 'show off' the Best from their own country, such as typical food, or sharing customs and traditions.

Weekend Arrivals and Departures

For our Residential or Host Family Campers, Saturday/Sunday may also be a travel day when you and your fellow Campers arrive or depart, receive warm welcomes or tearful goodbyes, and get to explore your new home away from home. And if you're flying in from abroad, don't worry about finding us, we'll find you, as transport to and from the airport is included in your registration! Language and Day Campers may book optional airport transfers with their family/group registration.

Safety always comes first!

In order to ensure the safety and well-being of the Campers, all our activities are supported by our professional GV Team Leaders and our GV Team Coordinator, maintaining an enviable average rate of 1 GV Staff for every 15 Campers. Staff members are chosen through a strict selection process and undergo an intensive training week before the summer starts. The team includes basic first aiders. During every activity, the necessary safety measures are strictly implemented by our leaders and any outside providers we cooperate with.

English Language Course structure

In charge of the programme is our Language Coordinator who supervises the lessons and closely follows the progress of each student. Suitable for all abilities, the programme emphasizes comprehension and conversation, and often includes topic discussions, role playing, group projects and local visits - this pleasant teaching approach helps to maintain a high student interest and produces impressive results.

Practice doesn't stop when class time is finished; English is the only official camp language and everyone is expected to communicate in English throughout the entire day. Overall, language students make significant progress in a 2-week period depicted on the detailed report that students receive at the end of each stay.

BEGINNER'S MINI GROUP

This course consists of four lessons per day and is perfect for those students who have little or no knowledge of English and require initial guidance into the language. New grammar, vocabulary and all language skills are introduced to increase confidence and to encourage the student to continue learning English.

COMMUNICATIVE ENGLISH

INTENSIVE GENERAL ENGLISH

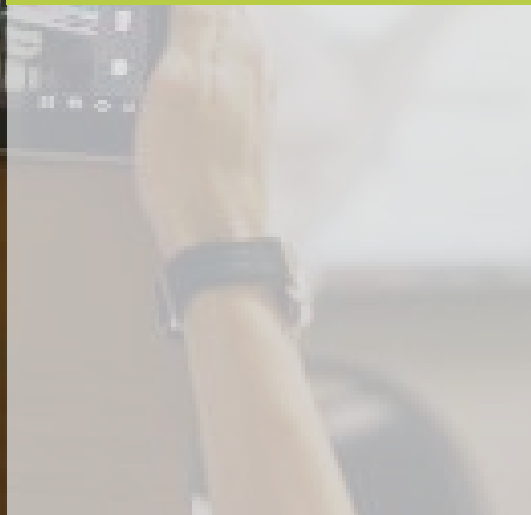

TOEIC

The Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) is an internationally recognised test which checks the ability to work in an English-speaking environment. The questions are based on real-life work settings in an international environment and can include topics like: meetings, travelling, telephone conversations, etc. The test consists of 2 separate parts: Part 1- Listening and Reading, Part 2- Speaking and Writing but the students can choose to do only one part of the test.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

BOOKING PROCEDURE

Ways of booking: (1) Complete our Booking Form via our website www.gvmalta.com or (2) Fill in the school's Booking Form and send it to us via e-mail: registrations@gvmalta.com. We will confirm the booking and issue an appropriate Letter of Acceptance and invoice.

GROUP ALLOCATIONS & BOOKINGS

Group allocations or provisional bookings are to reach the school no later than 12 weeks prior to arrival and are subject to availability at the time of booking. Agents should request an Allocation form to be completed with required dates and numbers for student allocation. A 25% deposit is required to secure the allocation or provisional booking. Should the confirmed bookings be different from the original allocation, the balance will be calculated accordingly. Confirmed Bookings are to reach the school no later than 8 weeks prior to arrival. All bookings are per Terms & Conditions

VISA

Students needing an entry visa for Malta must apply for a visa in their own country prior to arrival in Malta. Documents from the school will be issued upon receipt of full payment. Any postal charges incurred will be paid by the student. GV Malta cannot be held responsible for decisions taken by Maltese/foreign Authorities regarding entry visas or visa extensions. A refund less €120 + any bank charges + postal charges will be given within 30 days of written proof of visa refusal.

PAYMENTS

To secure a booking, a 50% deposit should reach the school within one week of confirmation and the balance to be paid at least 15 working days before arrival. Full payment is to be made for late bookings. When a payment is made by Bank Transfer, a copy of the bank receipt should be emailed/faxed to us as proof of payment. When effecting payment by Credit Card, you are to advise school of credit card name, number, expiry date, CVV Code and some form of identification. The booking will be cancelled should we not receive the deposit in the stipulated time. All bank fees are to be charged to your/student's account. Bank details are provided on the invoice.

ENROLMENT, ACCOMMODATION AND ACTIVITY CHANGES

Any changes to a student's enrolment after initial confirmation will incur an administrative fee of €20 per change. This also includes requests for changes whilst the student is at school. While we will do our best to change or postpone the course/accommodation/activities when requested, this may however not always be possible. If a student while in Malta, wishes to change less than 4 weeks of his/her booked accommodation, s/he will be subject to an extra cost of 3 days of the original booking. If a student wishes to change 4 weeks or more of his/her accommodation, s/he will be subject to an extra cost of 1 week of the original accommodation booked.

INSURANCE

All students MUST have adequate travel, accident and medical insurance before they arrive in Malta. If insurance is not booked by the school, a copy of the insurance coverage must be sent to the school prior to arrival. It is ultimately the responsibility of each student to have adequate insurance before arrival. We want to make sure that all students will be covered for any eventuality. Insurance policies are charged per week.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

All flight details as requested in our Booking Form MUST reach us at least 4 days prior to arrival. In the event of delays or sudden flight changes students MUST inform the airport transfer company in sufficient time. No refund will be given in the event of subsequent missed transfers.

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

We offer a variety of excursions and trips that one may choose all year round. GV Malta reserves the right to make changes to the activities programme due to weather conditions, attraction closures or any other reasons beyond our control. It is the responsibility of each student to have adequate insurance before booking any activity in case of any eventuality.

POCKET MONEY

Students should ensure they have sufficient money for the duration of their stay. In case of emergency the school will provide pocket money upon receipt of said money in the GV account. This will incur a charge of €20 per transaction, deducted from the sum deposited into GV's account.

PLACEMENT TEST

Upon booking and prior to arrival students are to answer a Placement Test to verify their English level. This enables students not to miss the first lessons on the first day. If a student does not reach the required minimum level for a specific course, s/he may be asked to change to Private lessons or another available course.

ORIENTATION DAY

On the first Monday of the course, new students are welcomed, given brief information and placed in an appropriate class according to their level. All students are kindly asked to arrive for their orientation on time.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FALLING ON A WEEKDAY

Students booking a **group** course are offered a leisure activity, instead of lessons. Should a public holiday happen to fall on the first Monday of your course, details of the Monday activity will be advised prior to arrival. No refunds will be given to those students who do not attend activity.

ENGLISH ONLY POLICY

In order to provide students with a complete English immersion, GV Malta follows a strict English Only Policy, where students are encouraged to speak only English.

LIABILITY

Students are liable for any damage caused to school premises or accommodation or any third party property. Before departure students must pay the full cost of any damage they caused. GV Malta will not be held liable for loss, damage or injury to persons or property.

DISMISSAL

GV Malta reserves the right to dismiss students for unacceptable behaviour or lack of attendance. No refund will be given. Repatriation is at student's own expense.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event that a cancellation is made after our confirmation, the following cancellation charges will apply:

- All students cancelling over 15 working days (Monday to Friday) prior to the course, accommodation or activity start date (whichever comes first), GV will refund fees received in full less non-refundable charges (registration fee and bank charges)
- All students cancelling 15 working days (Monday to Friday) or fewer prior to the course, accommodation or activity start date (whichever comes first), will be charged a cancellation fee equivalent to 1 week of accommodation, tuition activities, registration fee and bank charges.
- No refunds will be given by the school for "No Shows".
- Once the student has started his/her course:
 - Courses 1 - 4 weeks: Courses cannot be cancelled, shortened or lessons reduced in number. Course fees are not refundable. Courses 5+ weeks: Student can shorten course, but must give a minimum of a 2-week period of notice. The resulting credit can only be used to upgrade tuition and is subject to availability. Credit is not refundable.
 - Once the student has arrived in Malta:
 - Accommodation and Activities 1-4 weeks: Accommodation and activities cannot be cancelled or shortened. Accommodation and Activity fees are not refundable.
 - Accommodation 5+ weeks: Student can shorten accommodation, but must give a minimum of a 2-week period of notice. Students incur a 20% cancellation fee and refunds will be given in the form of a credit note. Credit notes are not refundable or transferable. If a student is unable to attend/cancels the whole/part of a course/accommodation/booking, this cannot be transferred to another student.

FORCE MAJEURE

GV Malta will not be responsible for any failure to comply with any of its obligations (and, therefore, shall not be required to provide any compensation) if the failure is occasioned by any cause beyond GV Malta's reasonable control; nor shall GV Malta be responsible for any costs incurred by or on behalf of the student as a result of any such cause. Such causes shall include but shall not be limited to war, threat of war, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity, natural or nuclear disaster, unusually adverse weather conditions and infectious diseases.

PRICE CHANGES

Prices may change if there are revisions in governmental policies, fuel or tax increases, or other unforeseen events beyond the School's control.

COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

If, at any time throughout the course, students are not happy with any area of their stay, they are to inform the school in writing before their departure. No complaint can be accepted after the end of the relevant course if it has not been clearly brought to the school's attention as explained above.

FINAL DECISION

If a situation arises that has not been covered by the above Terms, we reserve the right to take any fair and reasonable action that we think appropriate.

YOUNG LEARNERS (UNDER 18s)

Kids Club and Teens Club do not include 24-hour supervision. All students under the age of 12 are to be accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times. A consent form must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian and received by GV Malta prior to arrival. By enrolling your child at GV Malta you are providing us to act on your behalf in the case of an emergency. Parent / guardian is to provide a packed lunch each day. Participation in prepaid lessons and activities is compulsory. Should young learners not wish to attend any lessons or activities, the school requires written authorisation from parents / guardians giving reasons. Lessons and activities are not transferrable or refundable.

UNACCOMPANIED MINORS

Students travelling as unaccompanied minors require a GV representative to provide an additional service upon arrival and departure. The charge for this service is €40 each way. Please advise at the time of booking if the student is travelling as an unaccompanied minor.

ACCOMMODATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUNG LEARNER ACCOMMODATION

Host Families: Students under the age of 14 cannot stay in host families unless accompanied in Malta by a parent/ guardian. GV Summer Camp: Students aged 10-17 can stay in the summer camp during summer. Adult supervision is provided.

Hotels: Students under the age of 18 cannot stay in a hotel, unless accompanied in Malta by a parent/guardian.

HOST FAMILY ACCOMMODATION

Students staying with host families are entitled to breakfast & dinner when booked on half board and breakfast, dinner and a packed lunch if booked on full board. Breakfast is generally continental and includes tea or coffee with milk, and an adequate amount of toast with preserves and cereals. Lunch is generally packed lunch and consists of bread rolls /sandwiches, a piece of fruit and a small bottle of water; dinner in the evening includes a variety of dishes and mineral / filtered water. Students must respect the meal times established by their family. Students should inform their family about the foods they like and don't like, when they are not going to eat at the family, or if they would like to eat at a different time. A heater / fan will be provided when necessary.

COOLING, HEATING AND ELECTRICITY / GAS IN OUR APARTMENTS

Electricity consumption is included at a maximum of 25 units per apartment per day. Meter readings shall be taken weekly and excess use of electricity above the allocated 25 units shall be charged at the standard rate at the time and shall be divided between the number of students sharing the apartment. Use of other heating/cooling appliances not provided by GV Malta is prohibited. In the event of any additional appliances being found in the accommodation, these shall be removed immediately and a charge of € 5.00 per day for the full stay will be made for each appliance. If found in breach of the above conditions the school shall reserve the right to withhold the deposit and one may be asked to leave the apartment.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

When booking accommodation in a host family or apartment arrival and departure airport transfers must be booked through the school, unless a rental car is booked from the airport.

CHECK-IN

Unless otherwise stated, check-in is at 14:00 for all types of accommodation. Upon check-in students staying in the self-catering apartments will be asked to pay a damage deposit. Students who arrive during the night are required to visit school registration office the next school day and pay deposit there. If students' arrival is early in the day and they prefer immediate access to their room, the School recommends that the accommodation is reserved from the night before to guarantee immediate access.

DAMAGE DEPOSIT

The damage deposit of € 50 paid in cash on check-in will be refunded (in full or part thereof) on check-out, upon presentation of the damage deposit receipt and after the accommodation has been inspected. The damage deposit is held against any costs that may be incurred in respect of missing items of inventory, breakages, damages or excessive dirt that students may cause during their stay. Management also reserves the right to fine students where disturbances to other clients or third parties have been reported. In these cases the fine will be taken from this deposit. It is very important to note that students' liability is not limited to € 50.00 and the School reserves the right to charge extra money or take any other necessary measures as and when required.

CLEANING

Cleaning of the accommodation and change of towels and bed linen takes place on a weekly basis; missing items will not be replaced. Cleaning includes washing of floors and bathroom/s, and dusting of furniture; cleaning of plates, pots and pans is not included. For long - stay students staying 8 weeks+, towel and bed linen change is done weekly, while bedroom cleaning is done every two weeks. Even though cleaning is provided, students are responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their apartment and disposal of rubbish. Rubbish is not to be left to accumulate indoors as this will attract ants and other unwanted insects. Rubbish is collected on a daily basis and should be left on the pavement outside the front door in the morning before 08:00. Rubbish is not collected on holidays and should not be left out overnight. Students leaving untidy rooms will not have their accommodation cleaned and may have to pay an additional fee for extra cleaning services. Additional cleaning can be provided upon request at an additional cost. Please contact our Accommodation Coordinator for further information.

CHECK-OUT

Check-out on the day of departure is at 10:00. When checking out, students staying in the self-catering apartments or school residence should allow at least 1 hour for management to check the accommodation and refund the damage deposit. If a student fails to allow at least 1 hour, management reserves the right to refund the damage deposit at a later stage. In order to be checked, the accommodation has to be vacated and keys returned.

INSPECTION OF ACCOMMODATION

Management or staff can enter to check the accommodation whenever they deem it necessary. Glasses, mugs, pots, pans, plates, cutlery etc. must not be moved from one accommodation to another. When inspecting the accommodation on departure, guests will be charged for missing items even if they are in another accommodation. Posters, photos, postcards, etc. must not be stuck on to the walls; this is to avoid damaging the plastering. Students are responsible for missing items of inventory, breakages and damages in their accommodation; therefore, it is in the interest of the students who are sharing accommodation to ensure that any damage caused in their accommodation or abuse by other students within their apartment is reported to management immediately.

PARTIES

Parties must not be held in the accommodation. Loud music, singing, shouting or any other disturbance in the accommodation, corridors or any other public area is not permitted at any time during the day or night. In the event that this regulation is ignored, each student registered in the accommodation will lose their deposit and may be asked to leave the accommodation. There will be no refund for students who are asked to leave due to their misuse, abuse or disturbance in and around the accommodation provided by GV Malta.

KEYS

Students will be given his/her own room and main door key. Students staying in our accommodation will be charged for lost or broken keys and the cost of changing main door lock and key cutting. In the case of accommodation with host families, if students are given a copy of the house key and this is lost, they will have to pay the full cost involved to replace the door lock.

CHANGE OF ACCOMMODATION

GV reserves the right to have students change their accommodation during their stay. Notification in writing will be given to the student prior to the move. Transfers to the other accommodation will be assisted by GV. If a student chooses to change from one accommodation to another of the same category, or from one host family to another an administration fee of € 20.00 will be charged. If a student changes to accommodation of a superior category, the student will only be charged the difference in price. There will be no refund if a student changes to accommodation of an inferior category. The respective hotel's policies will apply for students staying at a hotel.

CURFEW

All students under the age of 18 have the following curfew times that must be respected: Students 16 –17 years old: till 23:00. Under 16: till 22:30. GV Malta reserves the right to make necessary change and to send the student back home if he/she fails to respect the curfew times. Should students wish to stay out later, the school requires written authorisation from their parents/guardians along with contact details of the parent/guardian for verification.
